
DARWIN TURBAN

SEWING INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Mark centre fold (pin or press)
- 2. Open material out flat
- 3. Gather along fold line, starting 1.5cm in from centre back edge. Stitch to within 5cm of front edge, turn, stitching one stitch at 5cm line, turn and stitch parallel to first line of gathering.



4. Turn in and stitch a 1.5cm hem along front extension (*straight stitch or zig-zag*).



- 5. Pull up gathering threads from wrong side, pulling up very firmly. Tie off ends. Reinforce on wrong side with tape or ribbon.
- 6. Fold tie ends sides together and zig-zag stitch from * balance point to point of tie end.
 - TIP: If you start with a 1.5cm seam allowance at balance point and taper to .5 cm seam allowance half way down tie end, this will reduce the amount of trimming needed to reduce bulk.
- 7. Zig-zag centre back seam from fold to small notch.
- 8. Turn tie ends to right side
- 9. Zig-zag stitch face hem (2.5cm 3cm) starting near gathering, to within 1cm from end of front extension, turn and stitch across open seam allowance, turn and stitch up first side of lower back seam allowance.
- 10. Continue in this manner to finish at top of front extension near gathering.
