SidSeagullCostume Conditions of hire

- Cancer Council WA insurance does NOT cover the costume hire. The hirer accepts full
 responsibility for damage to or loss (including total loss) of any part of the costume, and
 agrees to pay the cost of replacement (\$5,000), cleaning (\$50) or repair if deemed
 necessary by Cancer Council WA.
- 2. The hirer agrees to pay a fee of \$60 + \$500 excess bond to Cancer Council WA for hire of the costume **prior** to costume being collected.
- 3. Excess Bond can be cash or a credit card number. Upon return of the costume the excess bond will be returned if no damage has occurred and no dry cleaning is required.
- 4. The hirer must not permanently or temporarily add any Corporate or sponsorship logos/badges etc. to any part of the costume.
- 5. The hirer must collect and return the costume on the stated date to:

Cancer Council WA Gordon Basford House 15 Bedbrook Place Shenton Park WA 6008 (Monday to Friday between 9.00am and 4.00pm)

- 6. The usual period for hire is one week (longer periods by negotiation).
- 7. Due care must be taken whilst transporting and wearing the costume. Care is to be taken to ensure the costume does not get wet, and is not to be worn outdoors if raining.
- 8. Pick-up and return is the responsibility of the hirer. **Use of Couriers is NOT permitted**.
- 9. The wearer is requested to wear a cotton T-shirt and underwear under the costume. Socks need to be worn if the leggings do not have feet.
- 10. The hirer is requested to air the costume following use. The only item that may be washed is the tights/leggings (please read care instructions).

11.DO NOT WASH ANY OTHER PART OF THE COSTUME.

- 12. When wearing the costume, the wearer is not to speak but can use actions to communicate.
- 13. The wearer should not attempt to pick up children whilst wearing the costume.
- 14. No part of the costume, including the head, should be removed in view of the public.
- 15. The wearer of the costume should rest and drink plenty of water every 15 to 30 minutes to recover from the heat generated inside the costume.
