

Australia has one of the highest rates of skin cancer in the world, mainly due to exposure to ultraviolet (UV) radiation from the sun. To help raise awareness about the importance of sun protection and provide access to sun protection products, Cancer Council Western Australia's SunSmart Van can attend large outdoor events.

Why have the SunSmart Van at your outdoor event?

One in five Australians get sunburnt on a typical weekend. The SunSmart Van can help remind people to be SunSmart at your event. The SunSmart Van dispenses free sunscreen, provides information and offers a wide range of sun protection products for sale.

It is a community-funded service, attending events in the Perth metropolitan area. Please note: to ensure operational costs are met, the van will only attend events with a minimum of 3,000 adults in attendance.
