

FANCY A LUNGFUL OF THIS?



Remember that diesel engine exhaust can be a killer

- If possible, substitute diesel powered engines with electric or gas powered engines - especially if working in an enclosed space.
- Use extraction pipes or local exhaust ventilation when you've got a diesel engine running.
- Remember to warm up cold engines in a space with good ventilation - diesel engine exhaust is worse from a cold engine.
- Use ultra low sulphur diesel fuels if possible.

If you breathe in diesel engine exhaust, you could get lung cancer or possibly bladder cancer. It's estimated that one person every three days is diagnosed with a lung cancer caused by diesel engine exhaust exposure at work.

Don't let diesel engine exhaust be your death sentence.
