## Volunteer Position: Wig Service – Midwest

Cancer Council WA is seeking volunteers with a sensitive and caring nature to provide support and assistance to cancer patients with the temporary management of hair loss associated with cancer treatment.

Cancer Council WA Wig Service operates by appointment and is based at our Midwest Hub. The service has a team of volunteers who participate via a regular roster and are supported by a Cancer Council staff member.

### What's involved:

#### Key Tasks and Responsibilities:

- Washing wigs
- Sewing CCWA labels inside wigs
- Washing turbans, scarves, etc.
- Recording donations – and passing information on to me
- Recording 'returns' and passing that information on, where it is recorded into Aptify
- Helping with 'stocktake' (end of the year)

In line with Cancer Council WA policy, WA Government Health Directions and Public Health Orders, Cancer Council WA staff are required to be fully vaccinated against COVID-19. As such, the successful candidate will be requested to provide evidence of their COVID-19 vaccination status prior to commencing in this role.

Volunteers are needed for 1-2 hours on Monday or Wednesdays weekly, fortnightly, or monthly basis

As with all Cancer Council volunteer roles, you will be joining our team in the fight against cancer and making a difference to the lives of people affected by cancer.
