Volunteer Position: Gardener – Great Southern Hub, Albany

Cancer Council WA Great Southern Hub Albany is an accommodation facility for cancer patients and their carer's. We are seeking a gardener to assist with light gardening duties at the hub.

This position is ideal for someone who enjoys the outdoors and doing general light gardening & maintenance duties, such as sweeping, weeding, and general upkeep of the gardens.

Requirements:

- Maintenance and upkeep of lodge gardens and grounds
- Follow CCWA Sun Smart Recommendations to protect from solar UV radiation (cover up, use sunscreen, wear a hat and sunglasses and seek shade where possible)
- to be mindful of the distress of a cancer diagnosis and use a sensitive approach
- attend a volunteer induction and any role-related training
- participate in an annual reflection and any relevant team meetings

In line with Cancer Council WA policy, WA Government Health Directions and Public Health Orders, Cancer Council WA staff are required to be fully vaccinated against COVID-19. As such, the successful candidate will be requested to provide evidence of their COVID-19 vaccination status prior to commencing in this role.

Assistance is required from Monday to Friday for a minimum of 3-8 hours per week (days flexible).

As with all Cancer Council volunteer roles, you will be joining our team in the fight against cancer and making a difference to the lives of people affected by cancer.
