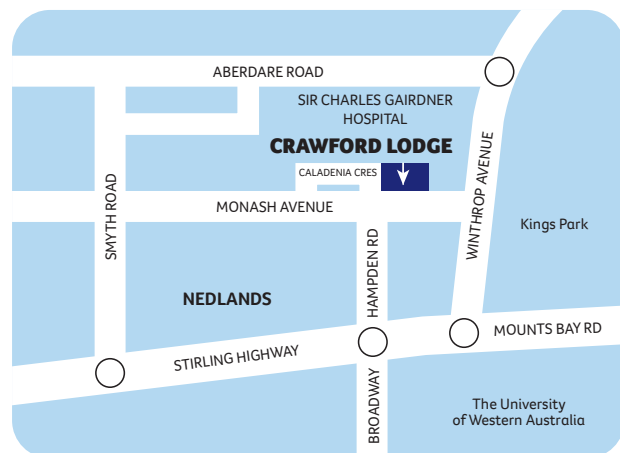

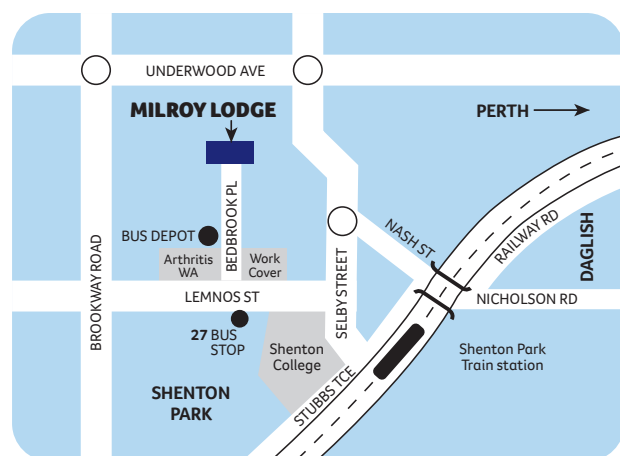

## Cancer Council WA accommodation in Perth

For regional cancer patients and their carers who need to travel to Perth for cancer treatment, our two self-catering Lodges offer comfortable motel-style accommodation in a caring and supportive environment.

Our Lodges have a mix of single, double and family rooms for short or long term stays.

Guests must be able to either look after themselves or be accompanied by a carer, as neither facility provides personal or nursing care.

## Costs and financial assistance

Current accommodation rates per night are available on request. If you live more than 100kms from Perth, or in Northam or York, you may be eligible for assistance towards the cost of your travel and accommodation through the government's Patient Assisted Travel Scheme (PATs).

Application for this assistance must be made in advance via the PATs Clerk at your local hospital or through your treating doctor, prior to commencing your journey.

If you are eligible for PATs cover, you may not incur any costs other than personal telephone charges as Cancer Council WA will invoice PATs directly for the cost of your accommodation at our Lodges.

Please note that if confirmation of PATs cover is not received by the check-in date, the accommodation costs remain the responsibility of the guest.

## Checking in

Rooms are available from 1.00pm. Guests are asked to check-in during reception hours unless transport arrival times prevent this. Check-out time is 11.00am.

### Reception hours at both Lodges are:

Monday to Friday: 8.00am to 6.00pm

Saturday: 8.00am to 12 noon

Sunday/public holidays: 12 noon to 4.00pm

## Support during your stay

Our Cancer Support Coordinator is available at our Lodges to provide social, emotional and practical support to all cancer patients and their families and carers.
