Our free Wig Service includes an extensive range of wigs in the latest styles and colours. You may borrow a wig for as long as you like, and exchange it as many times as you need. A range of turbans and scarves are also available for loan.

Fully-trained volunteers are available to assist you with the selection, fitting, and management of your wig.

If you have already lost your hair, please bring a photograph taken prior to your hair loss to assist with the selection. It also helps if you can wear your normal make up, including eyebrow definition.
