

Holiday Break Program.

Information guide



The Holiday Break Program supports West Australians affected by advanced cancer, by providing a one-off short break away at a subsidised rate and minimal cost so you can share quality time with loved ones.

Holiday breaks are usually available up to seven nights and located in Albany, Western Australia. Occupancy can be up to five people.

Unfortunately, wheelchair access is not available at the property. No pets allowed.

Eligibility

If you have been diagnosed with advanced cancer, then you are eligible for a subsidised holiday break.

To ensure your safety, you must be accompanied by a friend, family member or carer who is capable of helping with your care and who can seek assistance in a medical emergency.

ROOM RATES	
Up to two guests	\$60 per unit per night
Additional guests <i>(up to unit maximum capacity)</i>	\$5 per person per night

Availability and booking lead times

All bookings are subject to availability.

Holiday break bookings can be made up to three months in advance. This timeframe allows us to provide as many holiday breaks as possible and permits flexibility for priority bookings (*those in extenuating circumstances*).

At least two weeks' notice is preferred when making an application to book a holiday break.

Transport

It is important that you are able to organise transport prior to booking a break away. Cancer Council WA does not provide travel assistance.

Booking a holiday break

If you are eligible, they will provide you with a booking application form.

Once you have been provided with a booking application form, it must be completed and signed by a health professional to certify your cancer diagnosis and that you are well enough to travel. The form is submitted via email to albanyreservations@cancerwa.asn.au
