 - **Attend one clinic of your choice including:** Colorectal, Upper GI, Prostate, Thoracic, Melanoma, Gynaecological, and Breast. May also include observation of Symptom & Urgent Review Clinic (SURC), subject to availability.
- Fiona Stanley Hospital | General Medical Oncology**
 - **Attend two sessions,** comprised of a medical oncology clinic (general oncology, upper GI, or thoracic) and a supplementary MDT meeting
- Perth Children’s Hospital | Oncology Survivorship and Transition**
 - **Attend three sessions,** including an MDT meeting, a transition clinic, and an oncology clinic (high or low risk for solid tumors or haematological conditions).
